The Road to Freedom

*Live as free men, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil;
live as servants of God.*

1 Peter 2:16

As Americans, the concept of freedom is dear to our hearts. Our ancestors sacri-
ficed a great deal to secure and maintain our freedom from oppressive rule. This
freedom does not, however, give us the liberty to do whatever we want. For instance,
we cannot take our neighbor’s brand new car for ourselves or kill someone because
he cut in front of us. In the process of embracing our freedom, we simultaneously
place ourselves under the governing laws of this nation. We have traded one set of
rules for another.

In the same way, we as Christians have been set free from sin by the grace of
God. But that grace does not entitle us to do whatever we please. In accepting our
freedom in Christ, we consequently offer ourselves as slaves to righteousness. We
have traded one master for another.

Therefore, the road to freedom is not what most of us would expect. We actually
have to give up something, submit to something bigger than ourselves to attain it.
The following quote captures the essence of this thought: *Freedom consists not in
doing what we like, but in having the right to do what we ought.*

On this Sunday before Independence Day, as we think about the great sacrifices
that have been made for both our physical and spiritual freedom, may we resolve to
take full advantage of the right we have been given to do what we ought by living
holy and upright lives in service to God.
