Seeing God

I never had the opportunity to meet my husband’s paternal grandmother, but I feel like I have known her all my life. This is partly due to the stories John and others have told about her – how as a widow at age 34, with three young children, she went to college in the early 1930s to get her teaching degree, then moved her family to a poor area in the Appalachian Mountains of Kentucky to teach impoverished children at a mission school. She was obviously a courageous and resourceful lady.

But another reason I feel I know her is because I see characteristics of her in my husband – such as her passion to reach out to disadvantaged people in crisis and her deep love for the Lord. In many ways, John is the living image of his grandmother.

In John 1:18, the apostle John states that no one has ever seen God, yet He has been made known to us through His One and Only Son. Not only has He been revealed through the teachings and stories of Jesus, but also through Christ’s embodiment of Him as He “made His dwelling among us” on the earth. In John 14:9-12, Jesus Himself says that anyone who has seen Him has seen God because the Father speaks, lives in, and works through Him. Jesus is the living image of His Father.

As God’s children today, we also have the opportunity to make Him known to the world as we speak His words and reflect His character through our actions. May we ever strive to be the living image of our spiritual Father.
