Missing Item – An ecru tablecloth is missing from the church bridal storage room. If you borrowed it, please return it to the church office.





Reborn in Christ

Texas prison officials called him "the meanest man in Texas." Clyde Thompson was sent to prison for murdering two men, then killed two more after he got there. His reputation for excessive rage and violence earned him the respect of his fellow inmates and the fear of the prison guards. Everyone knew it would take a miracle to save this man.

That miracle came ten years after Thompson's incarceration began, when he asked for a Bible to read to relieve the boredom of his isolation cell. As he read, God's Spirit began to work on his heart. Slowly his perspective of life and God changed, and he eventually surrendered his life to the Lord and was transformed into a new person. The guards noticed the change in his behavior and began to let him out of his cell for some exercise time and then brief interaction with other prisoners. He would share with them what he was learning from the Scriptures. Several years later, he was removed from isolation and then 17 years after receiving his Bible, was released from prison on a conditional pardon signed by the governor. He spent the remaining 24 years of his life sharing his story of faith and the good news of Jesus with prisoners across the state.

Jesus says in John 3 that to enter God's kingdom, we must be spiritually reborn. God's Spirit is like the wind – we can't tell where it comes from or where it is going, but we can see its impact. The greatest evidence of the existence and work of God is a genuinely changed life.

So on those days when you wonder if there is any hope for you, remember Clyde Thompson. If the Spirit of God can so radically change the heart of a man like him, then He has the power to transform you as well.
