worship service.

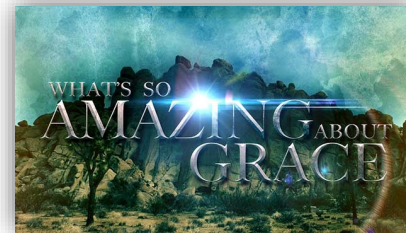
Ladies' Bible Class is dismissed for

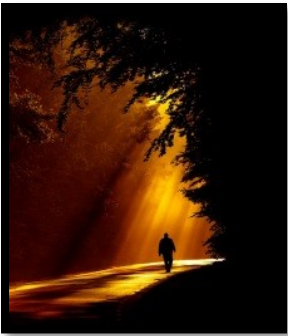

It was the darkest place I have ever been. I was a young girl touring the Carlsbad Caverns of New Mexico with my family. The guide had taken us far down into the depths of the cave and then turned out the lights for a few seconds so that we could experience true darkness. Without the light of a bedside clock or moonlight shining through a window, I could not see even the faintest outline of the hand I held up in front of my face. We were swallowed up by total and complete blackness.
