
Light of the World

For the Jews, the Feast of Tabernacles commemorated the wilderness wanderings of God's people during the time of Moses. Historians record that a special ceremony called, "The Illumination of the Temple" traditionally took place in Jerusalem on the first evening of the feast. In the center of the temple court, four huge candelabras were lit after dark. It is said that every corner of the city was lit up with their brilliance. All night the holy men of Israel would celebrate before the Lord with songs of praise while the people watched. This ceremony was to remind them of how the pillar of fire sent by God had guided His people in the wilderness after the exodus from Egypt.

It was just a few days later, with this event still fresh on their minds, that Jesus declared, "I am the light of the world." Like the lights in the temple, He illuminates every corner of our lives so that we never have to walk in darkness. Like the pillar of fire sent by God, He guides us through the wilderness of life to the promised land – our eternal home. Only in Him can we experience this light of life.
