

A Never-Ending Supply

Bread and water are mainstays of life. In some form, they have a standard place in daily meals served around the world and are essential to sustaining physical life.

So it was quite natural for Jesus to choose these metaphors to describe the spiritual life He offers to the world. He qualifies these elements with the word 'living' – He is *living* bread given for the life of the world (John 6:51) and gives *living* water which becomes a spring of water within, welling up to eternal life (John 4:10, 14). And in John 6:35, He promises that those who believe in Him and receive this lifegiving bread and water will never be hungry or thirsty again.

So if you find yourself spiritually starving or parched today, come to Jesus and connect (or perhaps reconnect) to His never-ending supply of life.
