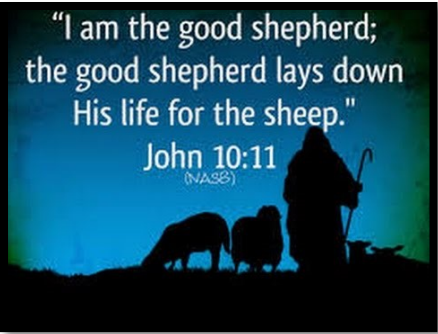

The Good Shepherd

What image comes to mind when you hear the word “shepherd?” Serenely leading sheep to green pastures and calm water? Gently nudging a stray back onto the path? Tenderly cradling an injured lamb in warm, secure arms? While these representations accurately depict what a shepherd does, they do not present a complete picture of the shepherd’s role.



David paints a vastly different scene in describing his actions as a shepherd in 1 Samuel 17:34-35 – “...When a lion or a bear came...I went after it,...seized it by its hair, struck it, and killed it.” David shows us another dimension of being a shepherd. He not only lovingly cared for his sheep, but he was also prepared to take swift, aggressive measures against anything – man or beast – who dared to threaten the safety of his flock.

Jesus uses similar imagery in describing Himself as the good shepherd of God’s people in John 10:11-18. Unlike the hired hand who runs away at the first sign of trouble, Jesus not only stays to defend and protect His sheep, but is willing to go to the next level of laying down His life to save the sheep. He emphasizes this point three times in these few verses, foreshadowing the sacrifice He will soon make on our behalf and impressing on us as His disciples how loved and valued we really are.

May we respond by listening to His voice and following Him.
