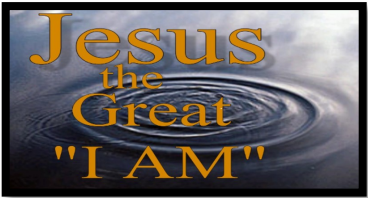

Prayer Requests:

The Great “I AM”

Several years ago, I watched a young man speak on a Christian video. The overall message was good, but I was taken aback when at one point, he casually referred to Jesus as a “dude.” His comment immediately brought to mind John 8:58-59 in which Jesus refers to Himself as “I AM,” the personal, most holy name for God. This name captures the essence of God and illustrates His existence before and after time. The name does not proclaim “He was” or “He will be” but rather “He always is.”



The Jews hold this name of God in such high regard that they will not say it aloud for fear of blaspheming (Leviticus 24:16), but instead substitute another name for God in its place during the public reading of Scripture. When hand copying the ancient books, Jewish scribes will use only a new, unused pen to write this name and then destroy the pen after writing the name one time.

So when Jesus uses the name, “I AM” in his discussion with the Jews in John 8, they understand exactly what He is declaring – that He is equal to Almighty God Himself. No wonder they pick up rocks to stone Him! But what they fail to realize is that if His claim is true, then in rejecting Him they, rather than Jesus, are the ones in danger of blasphemy.

What about us? In our casual culture today, are we ever in danger of dishonoring the Lord in our references to Him? Jesus is not a buddy, a colleague, or some “dude” on the street. He is the Most High God, deserving our utmost honor and respect.

Let’s take a moment today to stop whatever we are doing and bow before the great “I AM.”
