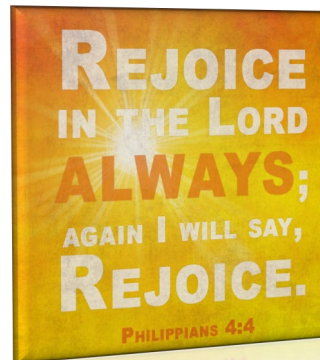

Prayer Requests:

I Was Blind, But Now I See

Have you ever had one of those “can’t see the forest for the trees” experiences? Maybe in searching for your lost keys, you passed by the shelf where they sat a dozen times because you were so preoccupied with looking in all the usual places. Or perhaps when going on vacation, you filled each day with so many activities that when you got home, you were more exhausted than when you left. It’s easy to get bogged down in details or false perceptions and lose sight of the bigger meaning and purpose.



In John 9, after Jesus restored the sight of a blind man on the Sabbath, it became apparent that the Pharisees suffered from this affliction. They were so absorbed in scrutinizing Jesus’ violation of their man-made rules regarding work on the Sabbath, they lost sight of the true purpose of the Sabbath rest and failed to recognize Him as the Christ, the Lord of the Sabbath. In the meantime, the blind man’s eyes were being opened spiritually, as well as physically, as his view of Jesus progressed from man (v. 11), to prophet (v. 17), to Lord (v. 38). In the end, it was the man born blind who could see and those claiming to have superior vision who remained in darkness.

Prayer for Today: Lord, help us to never become so focused on the trivial that we lose sight of who You are and Your purpose for us as Your children. Please open our eyes to see what You are doing in our lives and in those around us.
