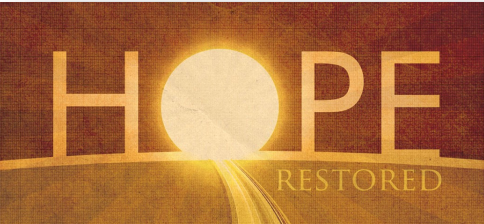

Hope for Peter

It had not been a good evening for Peter. At supper he had protested when Jesus approached to wash his feet and received an ultimatum – either cooperate or have no part with Him. Later in the garden, he kept falling asleep when Jesus had specifically instructed him to watch and pray.



When the soldiers came to arrest Jesus, Peter, in defending Him, assaulted and injured a man, only to be rebuked by Jesus once again. Then, just hours later, he looked up to see hurt and disappointment in the eyes of his Lord after he had dis-owned Him – not once, but three times.

Could Peter ever be trusted as a leader again? While we might have relegated Peter to the sidelines of ministry, Jesus chose to put him back on the front lines, leading the troops. It was Peter who later preached the first gospel sermon (Acts 2:14-41) and served as a shepherd of the church (1 Peter 5:1).

Have you stumbled and fallen in your walk with Jesus? Don’t despair. God still has a vital place for you in His kingdom. Come back, and He will lift you up, restore you, and give you the strength to carry on His work.

**Prayer for Today:** Lord, we thank You for second chances. Please lift us up when we fall and restore us to service in Your kingdom. Through Jesus we pray. Amen.
