LTC: Training Christian Leaders for the Future

For over 30 years, Easter has been synonymous with Leadership Training for Christ (LTC) in our family. We haven't had one without the other. The common thread of LTC participation has run through each of the four congregations we have served in our years of ministry.

As we celebrated this year's LTC successes with the kids of our congregation last Wednesday night, memories from past years flooded my mind. There was our high school chorus from a small West Texas town that amazed an audience of people from large churches in large cities with their ability to sing and harmonize together. I thought of the fifth grade student in our group one year who won a special "Best of Show" award for her extraordinary artwork. There were the teens who took turns doing "Mitchell Patrol" to keep our youngest son out of mischief while his father and I judged for the speech event. And I remembered our high school drama team that was asked to stay and perform their thought-provoking skit for everyone at the large LTC praise and worship gathering on Easter Sunday. Christian leadership skills were learned and perfected that are still being used today for the glory of God.

LTC has also been a place to reconnect with Christian friends from many places that we have met and grown to love over the years. As the author of a recent Christian Chronicle article put it, LTC "is like a family reunion for us. We have seen the tremendous benefit this program has had – and is having – on our children and grandchildren. It gives us hope for today and hope for tomorrow."

Although our children are now grown and gone, I am blessed to still be involved with LTC by serving as GCOC's coach for Preconvention and Challenge Events. It is my prayer that LTC will continue for many years to come, training the children of the current Generation Z and beyond for Christian leadership and service.
