## Church Health Check-up

As we go through life, doctors recommend having annual check-ups to evaluate the overall physical condition of our bodies. A thorough examination may confirm our perception of good health, but it may also reveal hidden areas of concern that need to be addressed.

It makes sense that people should also have periodic check-ups of their spiritual health as well. Christians are instructed in 2 Corinthians 13:5 to “examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith...” This examination can and should be done both individually and collectively as the body of Christ. How does a church go about making such an evaluation?

Our church leaders have recently consulted with the Siburt Institute for Church Ministry at Abilene Christian University, which provides resources to help churches grow and flourish. One tool the Institute offers is the Church Health Assessment. This church-wide survey is a useful way to do a “check-up” on a congregation’s health by measuring nine different areas of the church. After the members complete the survey, Dr. Carson Reed, Vice-President for Church Relations at ACU and Executive Director of the Siburt Institute, will compile the survey results and present an overview to our church leaders of how the congregation is doing in those nine categories.

The link to the survey will be sent to our members by email and will be available on the church website and Facebook page beginning today. It only takes about ten minutes to complete. Each individual member is asked to fill out a separate survey rather than submitting one survey as a family. Those who don’t have access to a computer may complete the survey at one of the computer stations that will be set up at the church building at designated times, and church staff will be available to help you get started. The deadline for completing the survey is Monday, April 30.

Make plans now to give your input regarding this important assessment of our church’s overall health. We want to hear from you!
