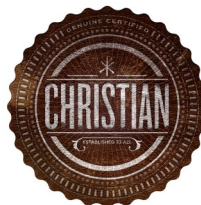

See the Body

The Bible says Christians are the body of Christ (Ephesians 1:23). Around the world we’re His body, and right here today, in this room, we are too:

- The people we like and the people we don’t like so much.
- People we admire . . . and people who “just don’t get it”—whatever our particular “it” is.
- People who are healthy and people who are sick.
- People who are doing well and people who are struggling.
- People who are new here and people who are always here.
- Young people and old people.
- People like me, and people like you, here, today.

The apostle Paul wrote that we need to recognize the body of the Lord during Communion (1 Corinthians 11:29). The Christians he wrote to were having a hard time with that. They gathered for a meal together before Communion, but not every-one got to eat—some in the church who were quite poor came without any food, and no one was sharing with them. Paul said the people in that church needed to really see one another in order to see the body and blood of Christ during Communion. How we relate to one another is that important! In fact, Hebrews 12:15 says, “Look after each other so that none of you fails to receive the grace of God” (NLT).

Maybe during Communion today, we could lift our heads and open our eyes and look around at each other for a minute.

Because Jesus didn’t die just for you or just for me. He died for us.
