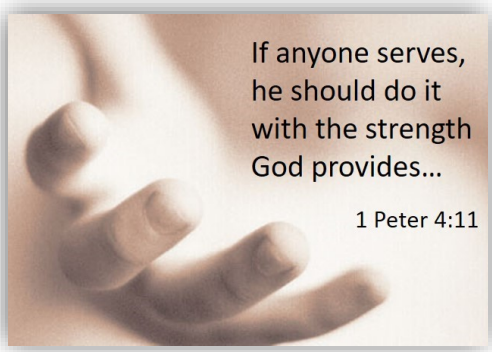
Strength to Serve
