Don't Take Advantage

Human trafficking...identity theft...investment scams... Our world is full of people who actively exploit those who are innocent and vulnerable.

Most of us as Christians have probably never committed such crimes, but we may be tempted to take advantage of others on a smaller scale – like using our financial clout to manipulate things our way, exerting our authority to force someone's submission, or leveraging a friendship to get something we want. The Scriptures are clear – in both the Old and New Testaments – that taking advantage of others in any context is a serious offense in God's eyes and will be punished by Him (see Leviticus 25:14-17; Proverbs 22:22-23; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8).

In fulfilling His mission on earth to preach good news, proclaim freedom, and release the oppressed (Luke 4:18-19), Jesus led the way in modeling how we should interact with others. He tore down social, economic, and religious barriers as He reached out to people of different races, classes, and beliefs. Through His teaching, He challenges us to turn the other cheek, go the extra mile, and treat others as we want to be treated (Matthew 5-7). To follow Him means there is no room or tolerance for taking advantage of others. Instead we are to consider others better than ourselves and look out for their interests above our own (Philippians 2:3-4).

As you listen to John's message this morning, think about what may need to change in the way you deal with the people in your world today.
