Where Is Jesus?

...But I am among you as one who serves. Luke 22:27

Picture a very formal banquet. At the head table are several dignitaries. Many other well-dressed guests are finding and taking their seats. Their smiles and happy chatter speak of their joy and honor at being invited.

As your eyes sweep the great banquet hall, you see people standing at the edges and in the shadows. Easily identified by their uniforms, the wait staff are watching for the signal to begin serving the feast. With trays in hand, their next move is dependent on the summons from the master of the banquet.

The tinkling sound of metal on crystal is used to quiet the crowd. After a few opening remarks from the master of ceremonies, the servers spring into action. Moving quickly and efficiently from table to table and guest to guest, they are hardly even noticed by those sitting at the tables.

Now, ask yourself, "Where is Jesus in this picture?" The scripture above answers the question for us. The answer turns our world upside down. In the context of declaring Himself as "one who serves," Jesus speaks of "kings" and "lordship" and "authority." While each term fully and finally describes our Lord, He says He has taken a place with the servants – the folks standing at the edges. That's not at all where we would expect the King of kings and Lord of lords to be. Now, ask yourself, "Where am I?"

Prayer for Today: Our Father in heaven, by the humility You chose, we are chastened and humbled. Forgive us when we forget the place to which You have called us. In Jesus' name. Amen.
