Breaching the Dam

Starting a quarrel is like breaching a dam.
Proverbs 17:14a

In the classic film *Force 10 From Navarone*, a secret operative team destroys a dam by setting off several small explosives deep inside the dam. At first, nothing seems to happen, but eventually small cracks appear within, which grow larger from the pressure of the water. Once the water begins to seep in and fill the cracks, the flow builds until the entire dam collapses.



The same principle is true for any nation, organization or group – conflict and division within will cause ultimate ruin. And nothing fuels that division and destruction faster than gossip. It is insidious, quietly seeping in and filling the small cracks of dissension, then swelling and breaking everything apart. It shatters trust, causing irreparable damage. We can wreck a precious friendship or body of Christians in the blink of an eye with a few hasty, hurtful words. Like the water gushing through the breached dam, once the words are out of our mouths, they cannot be taken back.

Prayer for Today: Lord, may I say or do nothing to create or fill cracks of dissension within Your church that will eventually cause its collapse. Help me to always think through my words before I say them to be sure they are loving and encouraging rather than destructive. In Jesus’ name. Amen.
