The concept of family is one of the primary ways the church is described in Scripture – for example, the family of believers in Galatians 6:9-10 and the family of God in 1 Timothy 3:14-15. The terms “brother” and “sister” are used about 450 times in the New Testament, with the vast majority of those referring to spiritual relationships within the church.



Sharing a meal at Camp Covadonga

Javier Adame, our mission partner in Chihuahua, Mexico, recently informed us that the church he serves was blessed to participate in a special family event this past summer. They spent a week at Camp Covadonga in the neighboring state of Durango. This Christian camp – complete with dormitories, classrooms, worship area, kitchen, and dining hall – has a 30-year history of hosting churches from all over Mexico.

Activities at the camp included Bible classes and devotionals, VBS for the children, Let's Start Talking English classes, sports, and swimming. They also visited 3 *ejidos* (small farming communities) in the area and shared the gospel with the people there, resulting in 11 baptisms during the week.

Javier summed up their experience with these words, “Every day our brothers and friends could worship, eat, play, work, and fellowship a whole week together which gives us much good and so that our love one for the other grows. All for the glory of God.” May we all take advantage of the opportunities God gives us to be actively involved with His family, wherever we may be.
