Telling It Like It Is

@ Granbury Church Free Wifi

In a movie produced several years ago entitled, *Only the Lonely*, a mother was featured who took great pride in "telling it like it is." She did not hesitate to speak her mind and was brutally honest with those around her. Eventually she learned that delivering the truth in a razor-sharp package did more harm than good and only drove away the people she loved and cared for most.

In 2 Timothy 2:23-26, we find that the Lord is concerned not only with *what* we say, but *how* we say it. Paul urges us to have nothing to do with foolish and stupid arguments but to gently instruct those who oppose us. Quarreling has no place in a Christian's life.

A condescending attitude or humiliation of those who are ignorant of God's ways is also inappropriate for God's people. Our purpose is not to impress others with what we know or trap them in their faulty reasoning. Rather, our hope should be that they will come to their senses and escape the devil's hold over them. That objective can only be reached by "speaking the truth in love" (Ephesians 4:15).

So the next time you are tempted to "tell it like it is," remember our ultimate goal of leading people back to God and wrap your words with gentleness and respect.
