Answering His Call

"Follow me," Jesus said to him, and Levi got up, left everything, and followed him.

Luke 5:27b-28

What motivates a person to leave everything behind to follow Jesus when He calls?



- For Andrew, it was spending the day with Him (John 1:35-42).
- For a Samaritan woman, it was His knowledge of everything about her when she first met Him (John 4:1-29).
- For Peter, it was witnessing a miraculous catch of fish (Luke 5:1-11).
- For Mary Magdalene, it was being set free from the power and control of the demons in her life (Luke 8:1-3).

These were not "religious" people by profession, looking for a rabbi to follow. They were ordinary people like us who struggled with real-life issues. It was not a promise of wealth, fame, or power that drew them. They saw something in Him – hope of a new life – that prompted them to leave behind their old, sinful ways and follow Him into a new, everlasting future.

In this upcoming new year, we will consider what it really means to be a follower of Jesus. How will you answer His call?
