## Welcome Ray Vander Laan!

This morning, we welcome Ray Vander Laan as our guest speaker. Many of us have benefited from his teaching on the historical and cultural context of the Bible through his seminar here this past weekend and his video series entitled, *That the World May Know*, that has been used by several of our Bible classes through the years.

Ray, or RVL as he is affectionately known, has always believed that to better understand and appreciate the Bible, we need to have a sense of the land and the culture from which it came. Biblical analogies and examples were first meant to convey God's truth to particular people in a particular time and place, so the more fully we can appreciate those times and places, the more fully we can respond to the power of God's Word and become a transforming influence on our own culture today.

RVL received a Master of Divinity degree from Westminster Theological Seminary in 1976 and has continued graduate work in Jewish studies in the United States, Israel, Turkey and Egypt. He has been a teacher for 35 years and currently teaches high school Bible classes at Holland Christian Schools in Holland, Michigan. He and his wife, Esther, have four adult married children and numerous grandchildren.
