You Can't Fool God

*Blessed are the pure in heart,
for they will see God.*

Matthew 5:8

Do you remember this commercial from the 1970s? “You think it’s butter, but it’s not – it’s Chiffon.” The premise was that Chiffon margarine was such a good imitation of butter that even Mother Nature was fooled, and “it’s not nice to fool Mother Nature.”

The Pharisees in Jesus’ day went to great lengths to appear righteous before the public. Many of them were adept at manipulating the legalities of the law of Moses to outwardly justify their actions and conceal their true motives. They were good imitations of righteousness.

But Jesus makes it clear in Luke 16:10-15 that, unlike Mother Nature in the Chiffon commercial, God isn’t fooled, even for a moment. He knows their hearts and detests the very things they do which the world honors. They may get by with it in the eyes of people, but it will not pass muster with God.

So don’t settle for being just a good imitation. Decide today to be a genuine Christian – inside and out; otherwise, you may fool everyone else, but you will never fool God, and His opinion is the one that counts for eternity.
