

When joining the Sunday morning worship assembly of the Church of Christ in Athens, Greece, we would not be surprised to hear the service conducted in their native language of Greek. But later that evening in the same room, we might be amazed to find a different group of people singing songs, reading Scripture, and listening to a sermon in English.

This congregation of Christians – led by GCOC's mission partners, Dino and Mata Tzanetos – actively reaches out to the large immigrant community in Athens, which is composed of people from nations like Albania, Nigeria, and the Philippines. Many of these immigrants don't speak Greek, so the church provides them an opportunity to learn about God and worship Him in a language they do understand.

Take a moment today to thank God for the members of this church as they strive to "become all things to all people so that by all possible means [they] might save some" (1 Corinthians 9:22).
