Practice Makes Perfect

...everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. Matthew 7:24

One of my favorite Olympic sports to watch is ice skating. The smooth, graceful speed across the ice, combined with the powerful spins and jumps are truly awe-inspiring. How are these athletes able to accomplish such feats?

In reading the autobiography of one of these skaters, I learned that their incredible ability doesn’t come from just studying about the sport and listening to experts talk about how to do it. These athletes spend at least 6 - 8 hours on the ice every day *doing* it, practicing each move over and over in their effort to perfect their technique. Their whole life revolves around their skating regimen.

The same should be true for us as Christians as we strive to become more like Jesus. As James 1:22-25 illustrates, simply hearing and knowing the Word is not enough; it’s the *doing* that perfects and enables us to become like Him. Our whole life must revolve around putting into practice what we have learned. Obedience is essential to our transformation in Christ.
