Returning Good for Evil

*"You have heard that it was said,
'Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.'
But I tell you, do not resist an evil person.
If someone strikes you on the right cheek,
turn to him the other also...
that you may be children of
your Father in heaven."*

Matthew 5:38-39, 45a



In this passage, Jesus turns our tit-for-tat world upside down. Rather than give to those opposed to us what we think they deserve or the response they expect, we are to show them mercy. When they forcibly take something from us and expect a reaction of vengeance, we instead give them more than they demanded of us. When they insult us and expect us to lash back in return, we offer our love and prayers for them instead. We follow God's example of kindness and mercy to the ungrateful and wicked. And in the process of returning good for their evil, our surprising response just might cause them to stop and take a closer look at this Jesus that we follow. The challenge is for us to realize this and act out of our love for Christ rather than our own sinful nature.

Prayer for Today: Lord, rather than give people what they deserve, please help me to overcome the evil by showing them Your mercy and kindness, for I know from experience that Your love can change lives. In the name of Christ I pray. Amen.
