Daddy's Hands

This week, as I thought about Royal Family Kids' Camp and Father's Day, I was reminded of an incident that happened over 30 years ago when John and I were first married. An 11-year-old boy named Robert, who lived at a children's home, came to stay with us for three weeks one summer while his houseparents took a well-deserved vacation. As a young couple without children, we weren't exactly equipped for such a task, so we borrowed an Atari game system and dug out our cassette player and some tapes to help keep him occupied. One of the tapes featured Holly Dunn's hit song, *Daddy's Hands*. The chorus goes like this:

Daddy's hands were soft and kind when I was cryin'.

Daddy's hands were hard as steel when I'd done wrong.

Daddy's hands weren't always gentle, but I've come to understand

There was always love in Daddy's hands.

As with many children in Robert's situation, his father had been absent for most of his life. During his time with us, Robert would sit for hours, playing that one song over and over and over again. It was as if deep down he knew he needed a father like that in his life.

The truth is, we all need a father like that in our lives. While some of us may be like Robert and not have that kind of father on this earth, we all have One like that in heaven. Like the daddy in the song, our heavenly Father is both kind and stern (Romans 11:22). He comforts us in all our troubles (2 Corinthians 1:3-4), and disciplines us as His children (Hebrews 12:5-6). Wherever we are, His hands are guiding us and holding us tight (Psalm 139:9-10). And no matter what happens in this life, nothing can ever separate us from the love in His hands. (Romans 8:38-39).
