Hearing Assistance

One of the features of the Worship Center sound system is a loop transmitter that permits hearing aids with telecoils (a "T" switch) to serve as an in-the-ear speaker. By activating the "T" switch, all the sounds received by the microphones of the sound system will be heard clearly with almost all of the distortion of background noise eliminated.

We also have several FM transmitters with earphones available for use during our worship services to aid with hearing. Go to the sound booth in the back of the Worship Center before the service begins to request one, then return it when the service is over.
