A Change of Heart Required

...And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God. Micah 6:8

The red and blue lights begin flashing just after you top the hill. There is no particular reason you were speeding; you always drive fast to get where you are going. You grudgingly accept the citation and later appear before the judge. "Yes, Judge, I admit I was speeding. Now, what will it take to cover this? A \$200 fine? Here's my debit card. A defensive driving course? Sign me up. Just tell me what I need to do, and I will take care of it so I can get back to my normal life." You have no intention of changing your driving habits. You just want to clear up the offense and get on with "business as usual."

The red and blue lights begin flashing, so to speak, for the man of Judah in Micah 6:1-8. His practice of adding a little weight to the scales in his business has been discovered (verse 11). "Yes, Lord, I admit that I have sinned. Now, what will it take to cover this? Burnt offerings of yearling calves or rams? Ten thousand rivers of oil? I can even offer my firstborn child. Just tell me what I need to do, so I can take care of it and get on with my life."

And the Lord says, "You can't pay Me off with a few sacrifices and external demonstrations of worship. It has to go deeper than that. I have shown you what is good. I expect you to do what is right, just and fair. My will is for you to sincerely love mercy and kindness and extend it to those around you. And I want you to walk with Me - all of the time, every day, in everything you do - with a humble and obedient attitude. Lip service is not enough. I require a change of heart, a change of life."
