Armor of God

...put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground... Ephesians 6:13

Several years ago, the newly formed Hood County SWAT team conducted their training in our church building. First, they gathered in the Teen Center to discuss various strategies in dealing with dangerous situations. Then they cordoned off a large section of the building and practiced the techniques they had learned in the maze of hallways and classrooms. It was obvious to us who work here that they take their responsibility to protect and serve very seriously. SWAT teams understand the importance of being prepared for all kinds of hazardous scenarios.

When actually confronting a barricaded subject or riot mob, however, these officers also know that training is not enough. They would never enter a threatening situation without their protective gear – under-armor, ballistic helmet, vest and shield, tactical gloves and boots, and assault rifle. They realize that one stray bullet or miscalculation can mean severe injury or death.

It is the same for Christians engaged in spiritual warfare. We can sit in Bible classes or small groups every week and discuss different strategies for dealing with the various temptations and dangers of the world. But training is not enough. We should never set foot in the war zone of life without the full armor of God in place. The belt of truth, breastplate of righteousness, footwear of the gospel of peace, shield of faith, helmet of salvation, and sword of the Spirit will protect us from the spiritual forces of evil that surround us every day.

So before you begin the battle today, be sure to put on your protective gear. It just might save your life.
