New Prospective Elders Announced

Last Sunday, an announcement was made by the elders regarding the elder selection process currently underway in this congregation. Below is a summary of that announcement.

The eldership has recently been reduced by two with the resignations of David Wims and Mark Hackney. Over the last two months, the current elders have been working on a process to identify potential additional elders for the Granbury Church of Christ. It is a process that has been used here in the past, but so long ago that it is new to most of us. This process has been chosen because qualified men can be identified in a more expeditious manner and the process can be applied more often as desired.

After weeks of discussion and prayerful consideration of many men, the elders have settled unanimously on three men we wish to place before the church for evaluation as elders. There are additional qualified men who remain for our consideration in the near future. The three men currently being considered are as follows:

David Anderson ~ David and his wife, Renee, have been married for 28 years and have three children – Michela, Savanah, and Braden. David works in a farming and ranching partnership with his parents, Noble and Pat Anderson (former members) and currently serves as a deacon here in the area of youth ministry.

Jeff Berryman ~ Jeff and his wife, Kristie, have been married for 19 years and have three children – Bronson, Stockton, and Aurora. Jeff is a former GCOC youth minister who currently teaches at Granbury Middle School and serves as a deacon here in the area of biblical teaching.

Richard Snowbarger ~ Richard and his wife, Pamela, have been married for 25 years and have six grown children and sixteen grandchildren. Richard is a retired banker and currently serves as a deacon here in the area of missions.

The evaluation period for these men will run from June 14 through June 28. Should you have any questions or concerns about the qualities of these men, the elders insist that the guidelines below be followed.

- Go to these men directly, face to face, to discuss your questions or concerns.
- After meeting with them, if you are not able to satisfy any uncertainty, you may express that to the current elders through a scheduled personal visit or a signed written statement (anonymous concerns will not be considered).
- If the elders cannot answer your questions, you may meet with the elders and the men under consideration in an attempt to resolve any issue (this will be done with you, but not for you).

We, as the elders, are united in our support of these men and appreciate their willingness to serve this church, as well as submit to your examination. Depending upon the outcome of the church's evaluation, these men will be ordained as elders of the Granbury Church of Christ sometime in July.
