## A Vision for God's Kingdom

What is your vision for expanding God's kingdom and your part in fulfilling that vision? Almost a decade ago, Julie Broyles had a vision to serve as a missionary in Asia, and when the opportunity came to direct a center for studying English using the Bible in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, she took it. Since then a number of people have become Christians and join together at the Bible English Study and Training (BEST) Center for worship and fellowship.

Four years ago, to address the ongoing challenge for new Christians struggling to remain faithful in a society that is predominantly Buddhist, Julie began to provide dorm space at the BEST Center for young men and women from outlying villages who want to study at a university in Phnom Penh but lack adequate resources for the average room and board. To live at the BEST Center, they agree to study the Bible each day with the Khmer staff at the center. As they learn about God, those who become believers have a family of God to come home to every day to help them through those first precarious years as young Christians. There are currently twelve dorm students, with an eventual goal of twenty.

Julie is in the U.S. right now to raise funds to fulfill her vision for this dorm expansion. She will be in Granbury September 9-11, so anyone interested in learning more can contact her at 682-205-4201 or juliebroyles1@gmail.com to schedule a time to visit with her.
