Mission of the Month - Itu, Brazil

One of the benefits of longtime mission partnerships is the blessing of watching a church across the world blossom and grow through the years. In 1999, GCOC began financially supporting Antenor and Phyllis Goncalves as they moved to Itu, Brazil and began ministering to the 30-member church there. And now, 17 years later, we see the fruit of their labor in this congregation of more than 300. God be praised!

As a result of this couple's leadership, several longstanding ministries in Brazil have been established.

- Impacto Media Ministry This ministry to the masses includes the production of radio and television programs that are broadcast throughout Brazil, as well as DVDs and other resources that are used extensively by churches nationwide.
- Camp Roots This annual, bilingual camp helps young people, both churched and unchurched, learn more about God and His will for their lives and provides opportunities for them to serve the community.
- CURA This annual, one-week medical campaign provides free medical services for those in need in the city of Itu. Over 120 volunteers are involved, including Brazilians and Americans, serving almost 3000 people each year.

One of our responsibilities as a supporting church is to not allow our interest and zeal for this vibrant mission effort to wane over time. May we eagerly join with the Lord in the harvest He is reaping in Brazil!
